BH-Works can help SAMHSA grantees get data flowing between non-federal organizations and the SAMHSA Performance Accountability and Reporting System (SPARS), including:

- Generate unique client / consumer ids for reporting and de-identification
- Fill out SAMHSA forms such as the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) or National Outcomes Measurement System (NOMS) directly in BH-Works
- Schedule reassessment / follow-up interviews according to grant requirements
- Automatically send data to SPARS when forms are completed or manage the workflow for manual data entry into SPARS
- View collected data in real-time interactive dashboards
