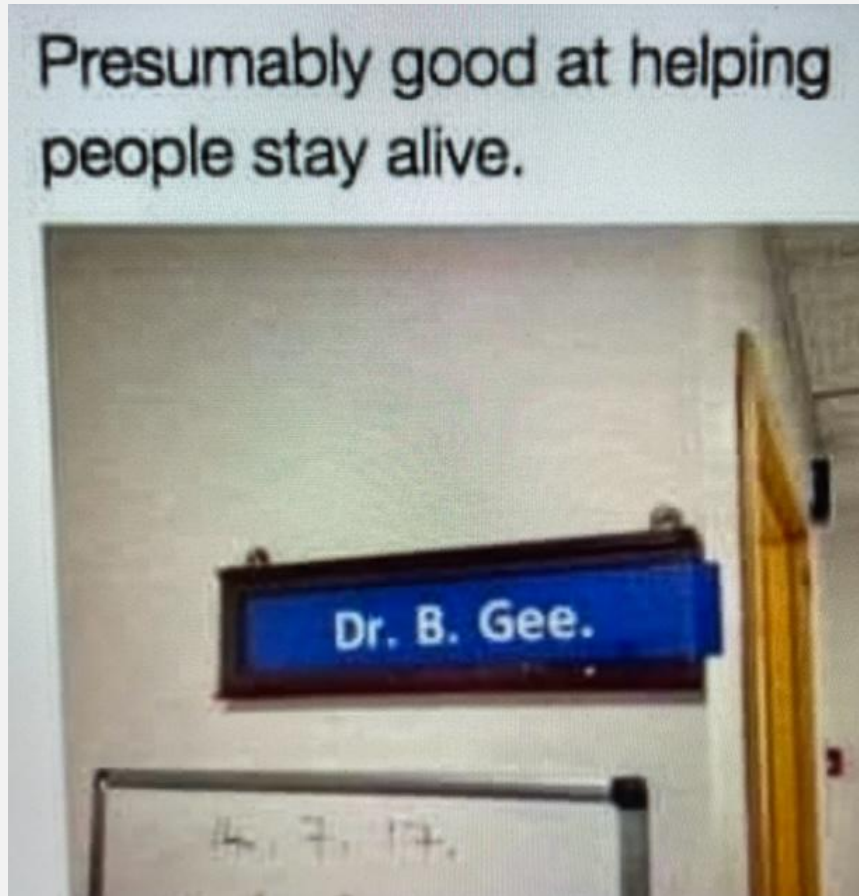

Data Collection Use

“The dashboards help me to know what is going on and help with staff workload. I have been using the reports as leverage to report to my superintendent on what the clinicians are doing to support students and to promote the idea of hiring additional providers,” said one Michigan ISD *bhworks* user.
